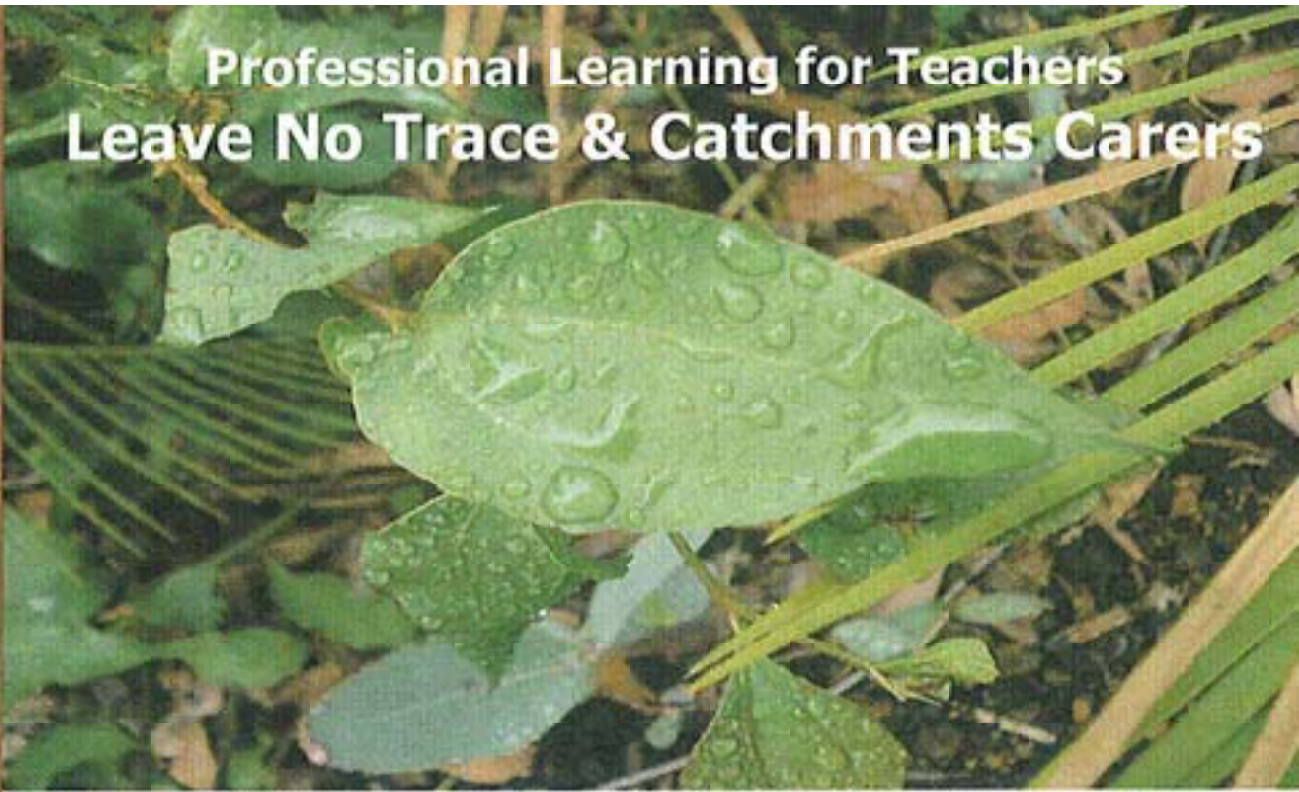


# Professional Learning for Teachers Leave No Trace & Catchments Carers
